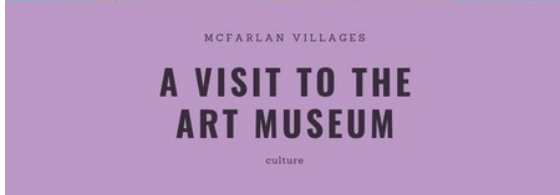

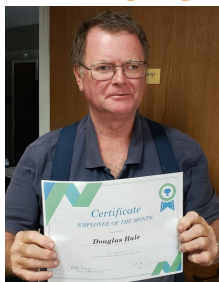

Resident Care Conferences at McFarlan Home

What is a Care Conference?

Care conferences are held for every resident at **McFarlan Home** on a yearly basis or when there are significant changes in the resident's

health. Care conferences are meetings that involve all responsible for the care of the resident, including the resident. During a care conference, the care team discusses best practices and creates the care plan. This allows all parties to be on the same page and provides the best care for the resident.

What's Your Role?

All parties involved in the care conference are important and have a part to play.

As a resident, you should feel comfortable to attend the conference as well as provide your opinions on your care.

As a family member, you may be asked to attend because your loved one needs support or is no longer able to speak for themselves. In either case, your job is vital. Sometimes you may be the only person able to voice the likes and dislikes of the resident.

As a staff person, your role can be two-fold, both giving and getting information. Sometimes the care staff at the meeting are responsible for making sure that those who did not attend are aware of the care plan changes.

Are Care Conferences Important?

ABSOLUTELY! Why?

- Ensures a team approach
- Allows everyone to have the factual information needed to properly provide care
- Gives everyone the needs, goals, and plans for the resident's care

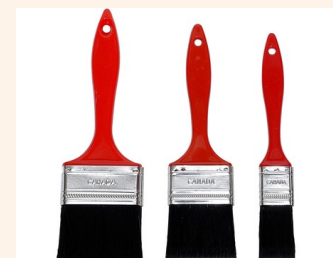
